Dear American Legion Baseball fans:

Of all the classic moments in Major League history, my favorite highlight by far involves a play made by an American Legion Baseball alumnus. On April 25, 1976, Chicago Cubs center fielder Rick Monday swiped a U.S. flag from two protestors on the field at Dodger Stadium. The protestors had just doused the flag with lighter fluid and were about to set it ablaze.

“Rick Monday... You Made a Great Play!” flashed the Dodger Stadium scoreboard, just moments before fans started singing “God Bless America.” Dodger third base coach Tommy Lasorda, a Legionnaire from Post 227 in Tustin, Calif., later said that Rick Monday, “beat me to the flag.”

The play was selected by Major League Baseball as a “top 100 moment” in league history. It would have been much easier for Monday to simply remain in place and allow the protestors to make their misguided statement. But that would not have been The American Legion way, and Monday still retained the values and character that he displayed years earlier when he was a player for American Legion Post 123 in Santa Monica, Calif.

American Legion Baseball develops far more than throwing, catching, and batting skills. It fosters good citizenship, sportsmanship and character. The players themselves deserve credit for their work, ethics and talent. But the role models who contribute to this outcome include their parents, Legion Baseball volunteers, and coaches.

For more than one hundred years American Legion Baseball has helped cultivate outstanding citizen-athletes. This year, in Shelby, N.C., we get to once again crown an American Legion Baseball World Series champion. Like so many of our other American Legion youth program participants, these young men and women represent the best of their generation.

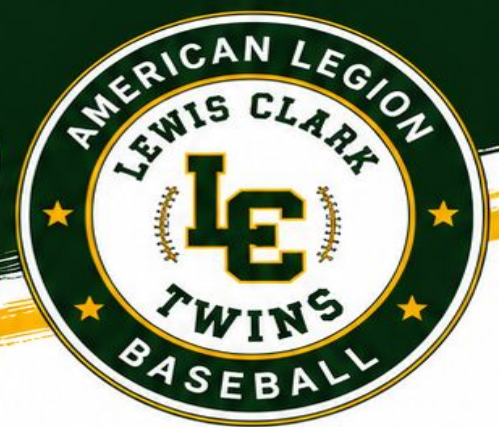
